MINOR AILMENTS AND CONDITIONS

You can get rapid advise and treatment from your local pharmacy.

The pharmacist may be able to prescribe medicines for these conditions (normal charges and exemptions apply):

- Ear-ache
- Teething and nappy rash
- Threadworms
- Hay Fever
- Cold sores and mouth ulcers
- Athlete's foot

- Diarrhoea
- · Skin rashes, impetigo
- Eye infections
- · Coughs, colds, sore throats, blocked nose
- Thrush and uncomplicated urinary tract infections

Just drop in to your local pharmacy and ask to see the pharmacist.

MINOR INJURY UNITS - for Adults and Children aged 3+ Minor injury units (MIUs) are able to help if you suffer:

- Minor cuts and lacerations, including:
 - * Minor scalds and burns
 - Broken bone (fracture)
 - * Cuts, grazes, wounds
 - * Foreign bodies e.g. splinters
- Minor head injuries from a low fall

- Muscle or joint injury, sprain, strain
- Skin complaint—inset/animal/human bite or sting
- Localised allergic reactions and infections
- Minor eye injuries and infections e.g. wounds
